Evaluation of infrastructure developments and new airport operations, e.g. at FRA, MUC, and other relevant cost-intensive airports.

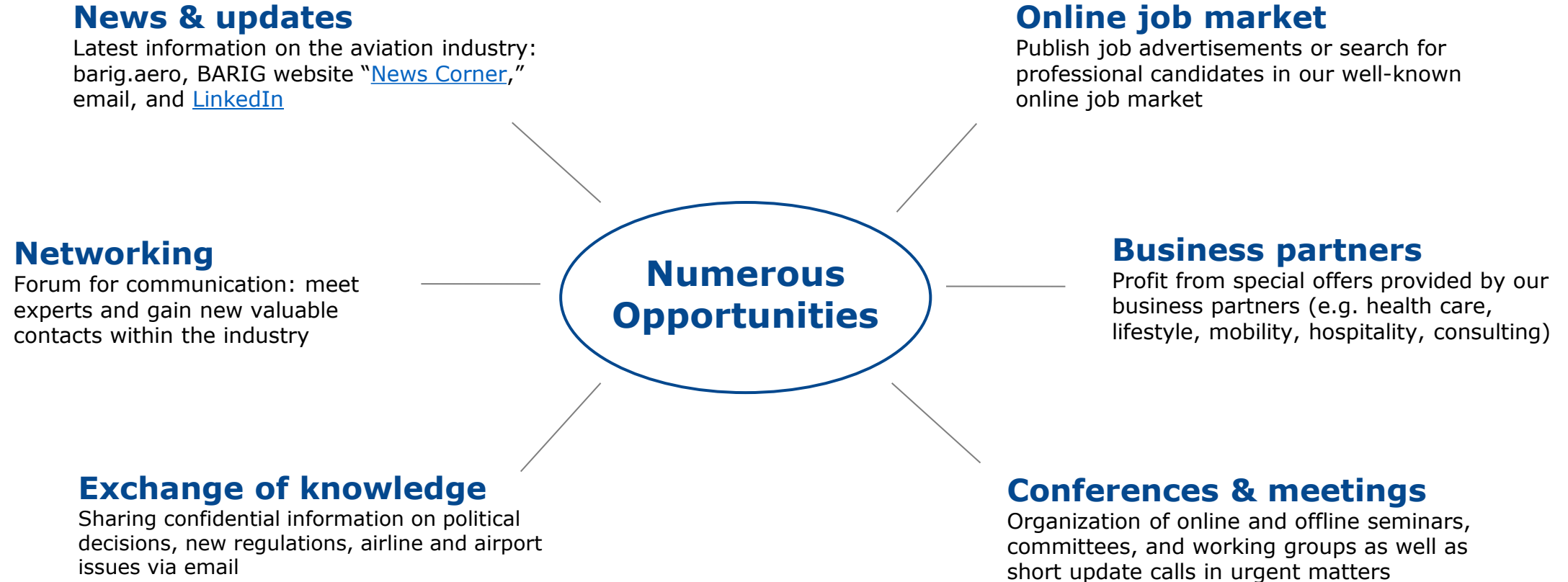
